- Hope International Missions received zoning and development order approval for the construction of a new 250-seat Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and Donation Center on their property on Nuna Ave in Fort Myers. The Lee County Historic Preservation Board also designated the existing 1920's residence on site as an Historic Resource. The structure will be restored and used as a parsonage.
